Neenah, Wisconsin October 8, 2021 – Neuroscience Group is announcing a new FDA approved treatment option, Relivion®, for patients who suffer acute migraines, a neurological disease affecting 39 million Americans. The independent medical practice is currently the second headache center in the United States to offer the treatment option. Relivion® is the first non-invasive multi-channel brain neuromodulation system for at home treatment of acute migraine.

Relivion®, which is worn as a headset, offers precise, personalized care to patients by delivering stimulation to six branches of the occipital and trigeminal nerves. This allows for the release of neurotransmitters in the brainstem and modulation of brain networks associated with control of pain. The headset is run through a cloud-based HIPAA secure smartphone application that tracks duration, intensity level and remaining treatment time, which is then shared directly with the prescribing health care provider.

Not only can it help people regain control of their lives, but it also opens new doors for providers to track their treatment progress in real-time and make adjustments as needed,” said Dr. Brian D.
